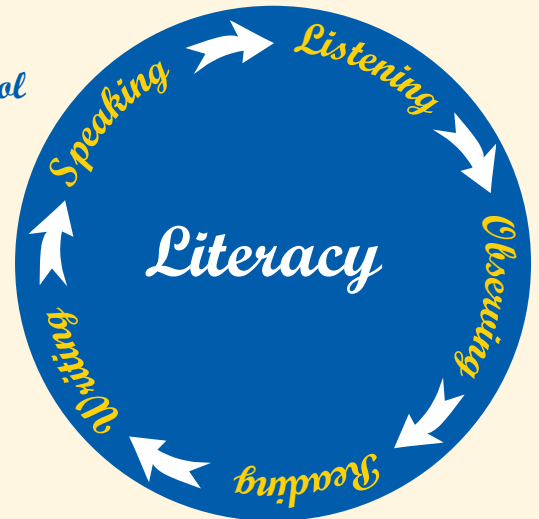
Each participant will receive:

This team, including the administrator, should consist of 6-8 members selected from the following: media specialist, representatives from each content area, school writing leader, technology coordinator, SBDM member, a student, a counselor, Title I Coordinator, limited English proficiency teacher, special education teachers who collaborate, and representatives from all grades and content areas. The team you choose should represent your school's demographics.

Package includes three six hours sessions. Dates are flexible, but we recommend beginning with a session in June, following up in July with the final session taking place in early fall.
